Ancient arts

Learn about the delicate Nabataean pottery style at the museum in Petra, and the next morning visit the workshop of the Taybeh Ladies Cooperative to try your hand at making your own piece in Nabataean style. After lunch transfer to Wadi Rum, one of the latest UNESCO World Heritage Sites, and take a jeep tour to learn about the ancient Thamudic rock art that you can still see today.

Day 1

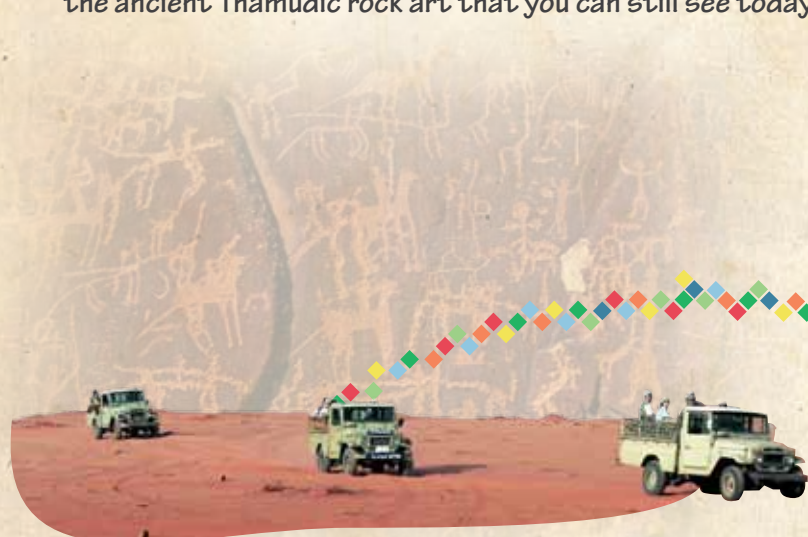
Transfer to Wadi Rum and lunch with

Visit the Church of St. George to see the Byzantine mosaic map of the Holy Land, followed by the Archaeological Park to see other ancient mosaics

Lunch then to Virgin Mary Mosaics or the Madaba Institute of Mosaic Art and Restoration for a mosaic class to make your own piece.

Overnight in Madaba

Breakfast and then visit Um er-Rassas, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for the complete mosaic floor found at the Church of St. Stephen.

Transfer to Amman for lunch

Visit the art galleries of Jabal Weibdeh, Darat Al Funun, Dar Al Anda, National Gallery, etc.
