building on the Memorandum of Understanding between the USAID Jordan Competitiveness Program and EDAMA, USAID JCP supported Jordanian females working in the field of renewable energy in a series of training programs titled Renewable Energy Professional (REP™). The REP™ certification, introduced by the Association of Energy Engineers (AEE) in 2010, is designed to recognize the expertise and experience of professionals involved in the specification and application of renewable and alternative energy technologies, assessment of renewable energy projects, and development of achievable low-carbon and sustainability goals for organizations. Participants who earn the REP™ certification will be recognized, worldwide, as having the highest level of competency in renewable energy.

USAID JCP has supported almost 100 females in taking the REP, as well as other AEE accredited courses like the Certified Energy Manager (CEM) and the Carbon Reduction Manager (CRM).
