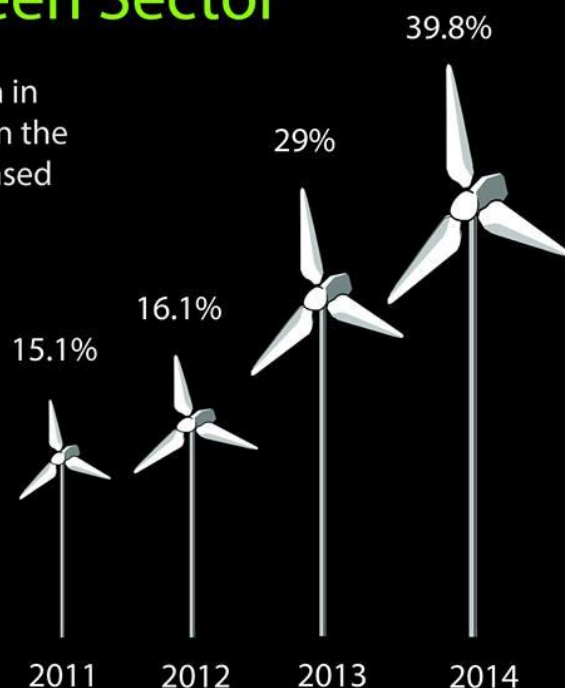

Clean Technology (CT) is one of the sectors targeted by USAID JCP to achieve these objectives. CT encompasses economically competitive and productive technologies that use less material and/or energy, generate less waste and cause less environmental damage than the alternatives.
