 DevResults is a web-based platform that will enable USAID Implementing Partners to report their program monitoring data in a standardized way, across the entire USAID/Jordan project portfolio



#### What is in it for me?

#### **USAID/Jordan**


- Gathering all data in a centralized place and a standard format
- Keep track of Activity monitoring data
- Understand alignment between Activities and strategy
- A/CORs should be better able to answer their own questions based on the data submitted. Fewer ad hoc requests or "data calls"
- See where you are working

### **Implementing Partners**

- A standard way to report on performance data
- Data is ready whenever the Mission wants to look at it



## **Key Functions of DevResults in First Phase**

#### 1. Monitoring and Evaluation

- System admin will set up Mission and IPs Results Framework and indicators and IPs will submit their data
- A/CORs review submitted IPs reporting and send revision requests if needed

#### 2. Mapping

Where you are working and appropriate indicator data (An interactive mapping tool)



## What is Needed for Monitoring and Evaluation?








- The reporting level is the geographical disaggregation:
  - Administrative Division(e.g. shapes that denotes areas on a map such as municipalities, districts, governorates, etc.)
  - Location(specific points on a map with GPS coordinates such as hospitals, schools, etc.)







  - e.g. Gender: "male, female", Age: "<18, 18+"</li>
- Whether the indicator is cross-disaggregated






## How is Indicator Data Entered into DevResults?
