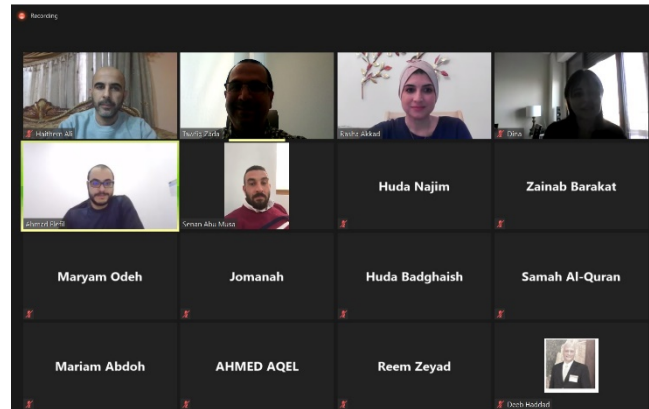


News article: “Developing Activity Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning Plans” Training for the USAID Mission Staff and Implementing Partners

The USAID Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning Activity aims to improve the quality of monitoring, evaluation, and learning within USAID and its Implementing Partners. To address the priorities for capacity strengthening, which were determined by the Training Needs Assessment conducted by MELA two months ago, the MELA team developed and delivered Activity MEL Plan virtual training on November 9. A total of 19 participants including MEL Specialists and technical staff from the Mission and Implementing Partners attended the training. Participants received an overview of MEL Plan components, including theory of change, log frame, and indicators, in addition to an overview of Performance Indicator Reference Sheets (PIRS). USAID implementing partners are required to report the results of their development activities utilizing appropriate MEL approaches.
