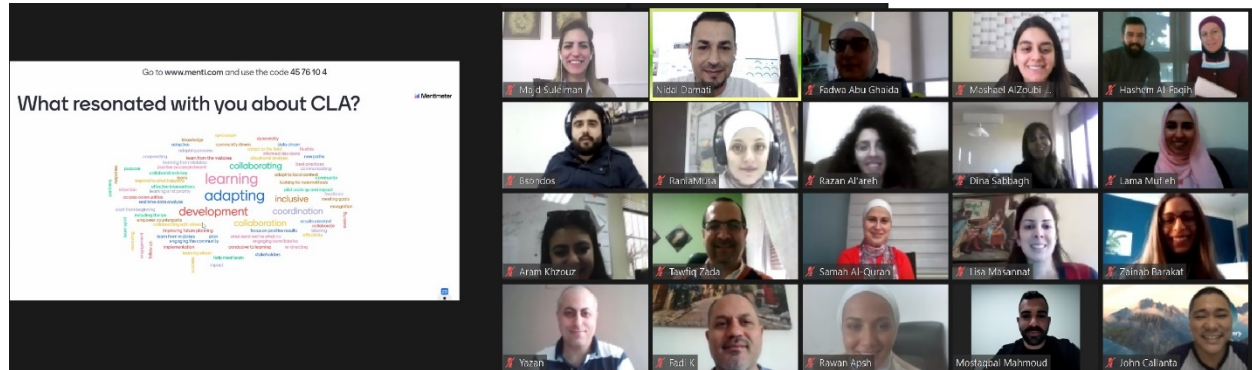


“INTRODUCTION TO COLLABORATING, LEARNING AND ADAPTING” TRAINING FOR THE USAID MISSION STAFF AND IMPLEMENTING PARTNERS

The USAID Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning Activity conducted an introduction to Collaborating, Learning, and Adapting (CLA) virtual training on January 11 for USAID Mission staff and its Implementing Partners. This training aligns with USAID’s focus on improving evidence-based decision making by incorporating CLA practices.
