


### **Integrated Program Cycle**





#### **CDCS & Results Framework**


#### Strategies are represented graphically in a Results Framework






# Relationship between RF and Projects

"Projects" are typically linked to an Intermediate Result (IR)






### The CDCS Operationalized






### The CDCS Operationalized






### How the CDCS is Operationalized and Monitored






### Relationship of Project and Activity M&E Plans to the PMP
