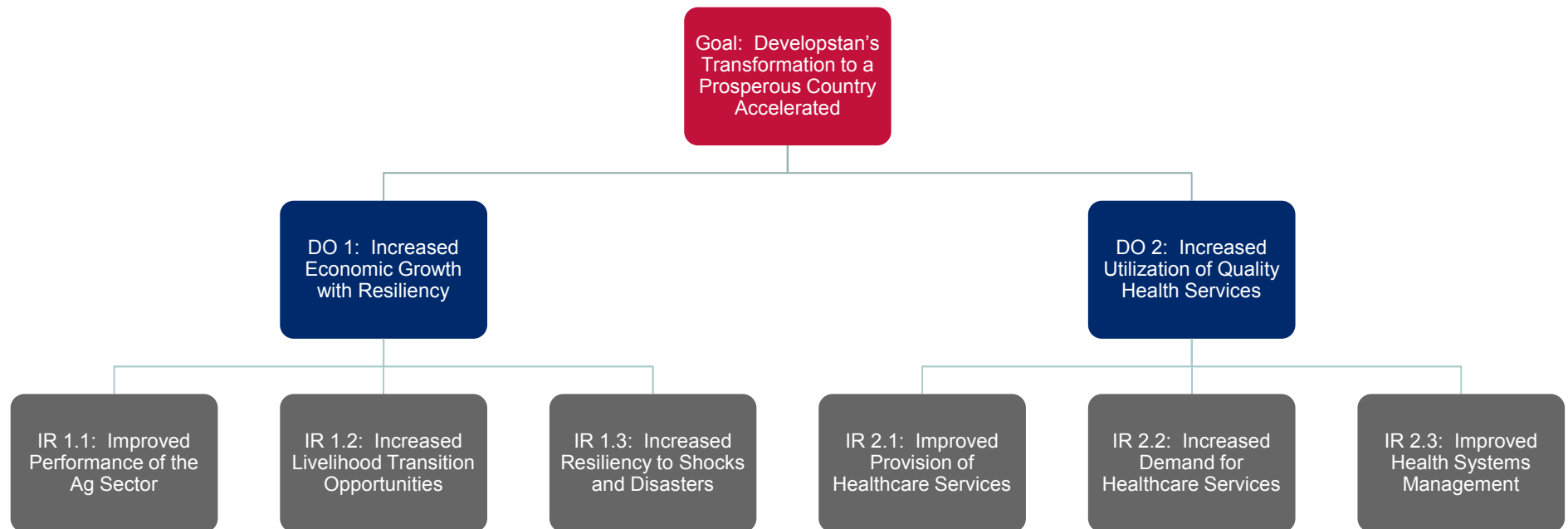
Integrated Program Cycle





CDCS & Results Framework

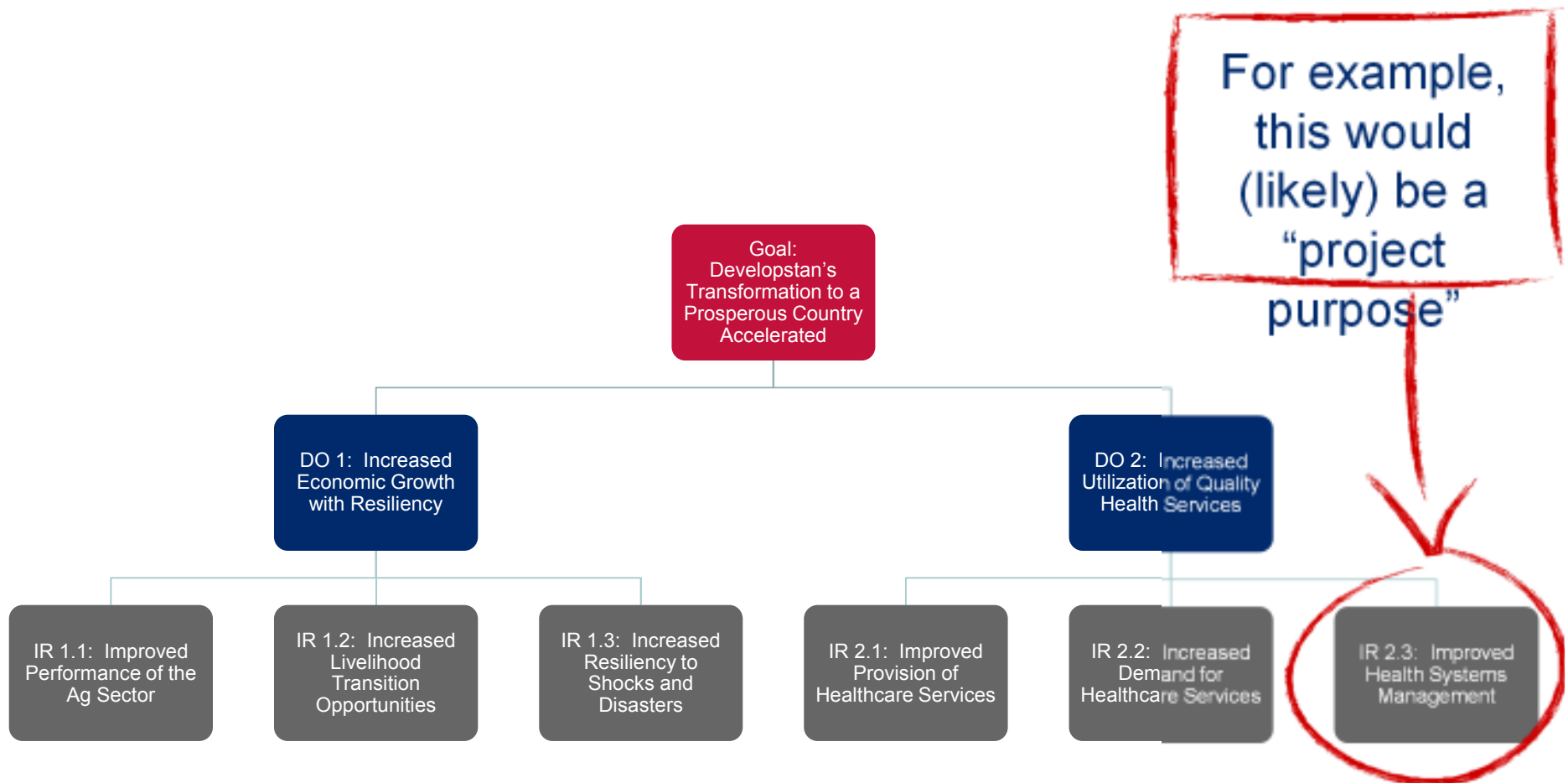
Strategies are represented graphically in a Results Framework





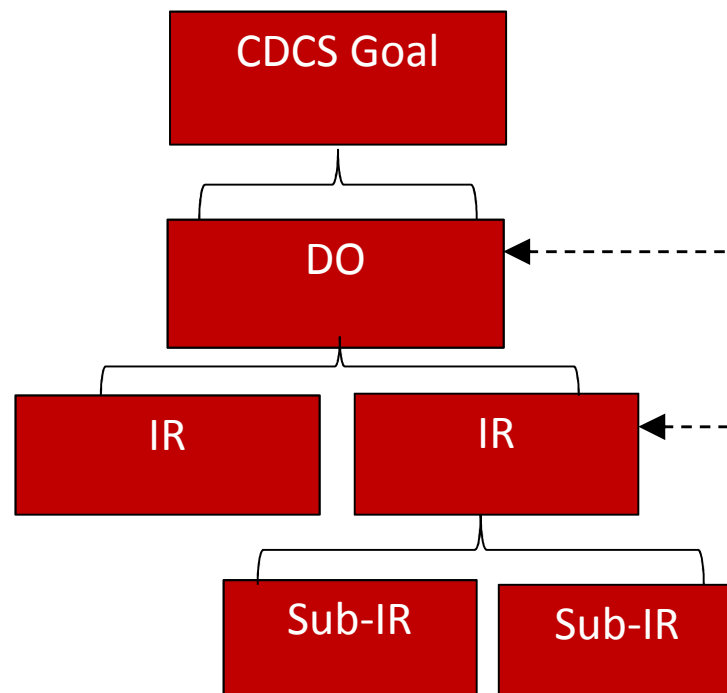
Relationship between RF and Projects

“Projects” are typically linked to an Intermediate Result (IR)

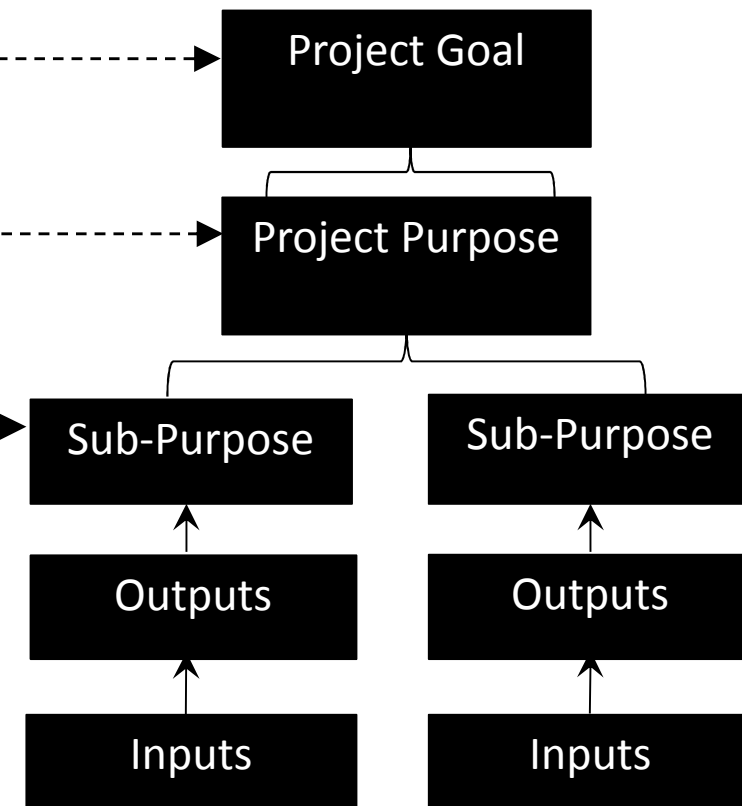


The CDCS Operationalized

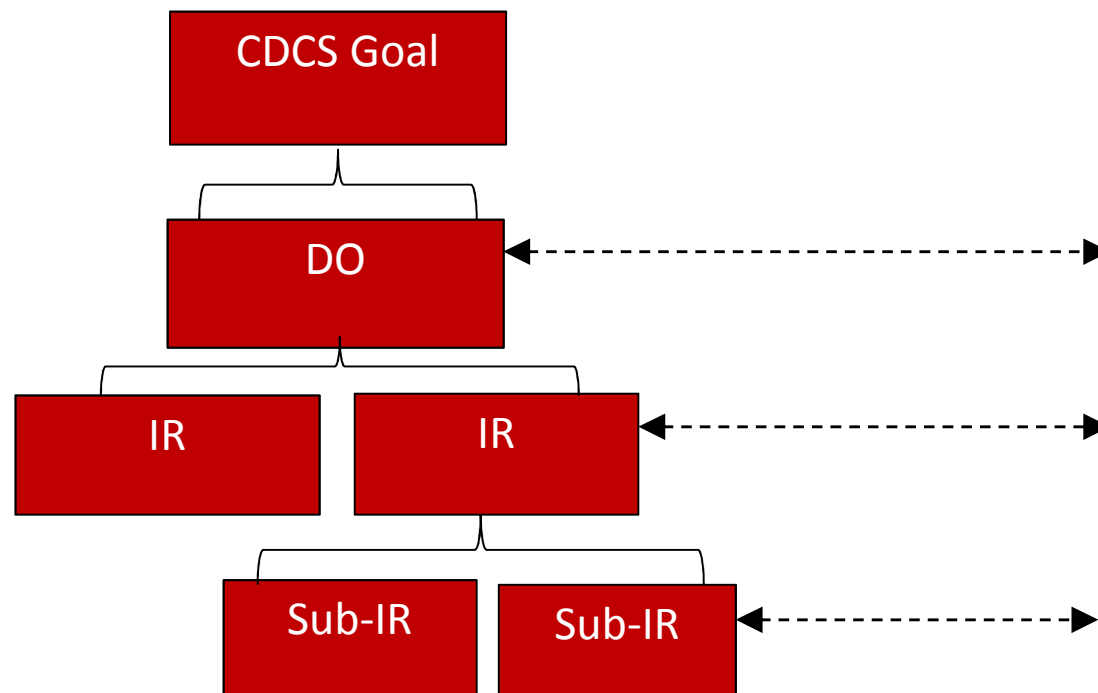

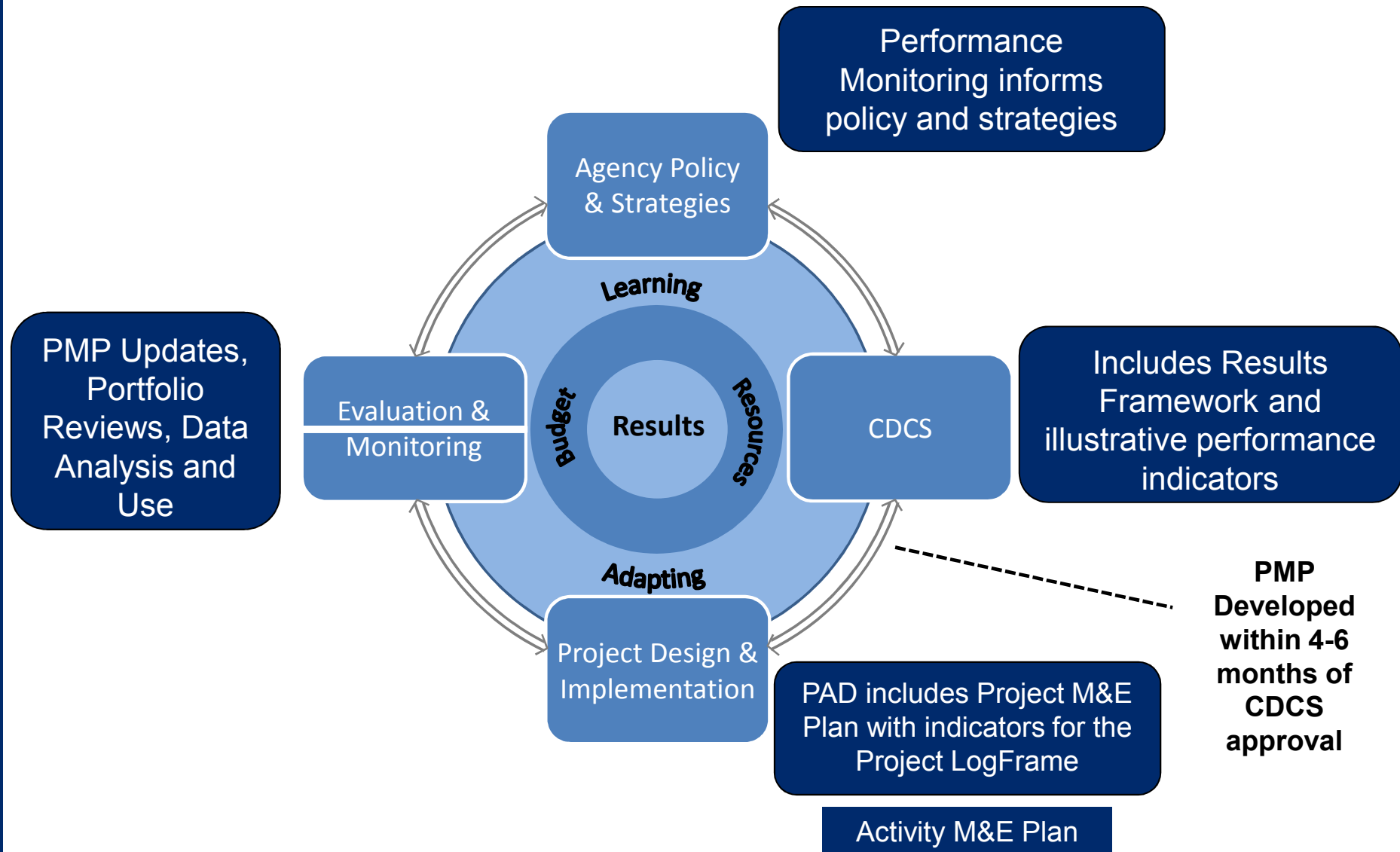


Relationship of Project and Activity M&E Plans to the PMP
