





### Investment Window Services and Facilitation for the tourism sector

The Investment Window at the Investment Commission offers the Single-Window Services: to help investors in the tourism sector obtain the necessary approvals and licenses for launching their business. The Window comprises representatives of relevant institutions authorized to grant approvals, licenses, incentives, and exemptions for the sector.





# Incentives and Exemptions Granted to the Tourism Sector through the Investment Window


#### Establishments eligible to receive (current and new) incentives



- ★ Impoted machines, equipment, supplies, spare parts, production input, and construction material used in the construction and supply of these activities shall be exempt from customs import duties and other fees and taxes. However, they shall not be exempt from the service charge.
- ★ Impoted machines, equipment, supplies, spare parts, production input, and construction material used in the construction and supply of these activities, be they imported or purchased locally, shall be subject to a zero general sales tax rate.
- ★ The services of the above-mentioned activities shall be subject to a 7% general sales tax rate.
- ★ A 5% Income tax shall be imposed on the taxable income generated through these activities for a period of 10 years, unless they are taxed at a lower rate in accordance with tax cuts granted for less-developed zones. In such a case, the lower rate shall apply and for the longer period.

**Note:** To claim exemptions and other benefits, kindly submit an application with the Investment Commission
