Policies

Improving the Situation of the Teaching Profession in Jordan through Key Policy Work in collaboration with the MoE:

- October 2022**
 - 35% instant pay raise upon hiring, and the immediate placement as Teacher's Assistant.
- September 2022**
 - \$2.8 Million worth of MoE scholarships covering up to 1,250 students from Cohort 2.
 - Appointment of MoE-Scholarship Graduates at Public Schools across the country in cooperation with the Civil Service Bureau.
- December 2022**
 - Recruitment of the top 23 performing graduates from cohort 1 by the CSB, directly into public schools.



Partner Universities and Diploma Students

Ensuring the program delivery is aligned with the upscale in student enrollments, the activity increased the number of University Teacher Educators, Mentors, Supervisors, and refurbished rooms.

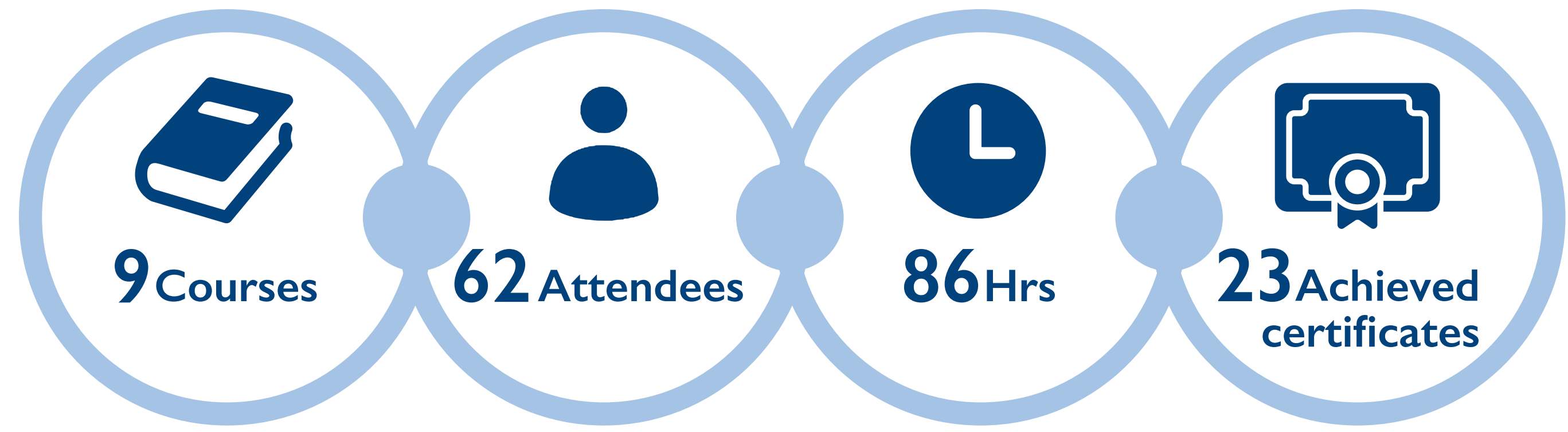

Satisfaction Rates

2022

In addition to the student upscale in 2022, the activity's stakeholders expressed their satisfaction its different activities according to the below rates:

- ★ **91%** of students satisfied with program preparation in meeting the National Standards for the Professional Development of Teachers
- ★ **85%** of PSC members satisfaction with steering committee impact on policies and actions
- ★ **97%** of enrolled students who indicate that incentives were a reason they applied
- ★ **62%** of university staff and other stakeholders are satisfied with pre-service teacher education reforms
